As a member of the NSCA and TSCA I have voluntarily agreed to abide by the rules and regulations governing competitions held under those rules and regulations.

In order to promote good sportsmanship and for the benefit of all competitors;  
In order to compete under the flag of Fair Play for All,  
In order to promote and strengthen a sense of proper decorum and behavior:

I agree to the following:

That it is my obligation as a member of the NSCA and TSCA to know the rules and to assist in the proper application of those rules.

That I will abide by all pertinent NSCA and TSCA rules and regulations regarding the competition for which I am registering and in competition.

That I will treat all fellow competitors, range personnel, trappers and shoot management with respect and dignity.

That I will not accept a target that I knowingly did not break, nor will I allow others to do so either whether those shooters are in my squad or another I am observing.

That I will not bend the rules, nor turn a blind eye to those who do bend the rules. That it is every competitor's duty to uphold the rules to ensure a level playing field for all competitors.

Recognizing that this is a family sport, that I will refrain from the use of foul or indecent language directed at oneself or others.

Recognizing that this is a family sport, that I will refrain from acts of misconduct such as but not limited to: fits of anger, throwing of empty cartridges, abuse of a firearm or verbal abuse of other individuals on the shooting grounds or in the general vicinity of the shooting grounds.

That I understand the proper protocol to protest a field judgement.
