Substantial amounts of crushed rock weaved throughout the course and they continue to develop high quality cart paths for the September Championship.

Official target setter Robert Crow joined us on site and left the grounds energized by this exciting opportunity. Many of you know Robert as the NSCA Sporting Clays Director, and as an accomplished Master class shooter, you should also be aware of his coaching and target setting savvy. Robert was the director of the Nemicolin academy back East, and was responsible for setting championship targets at several big blasts.
